

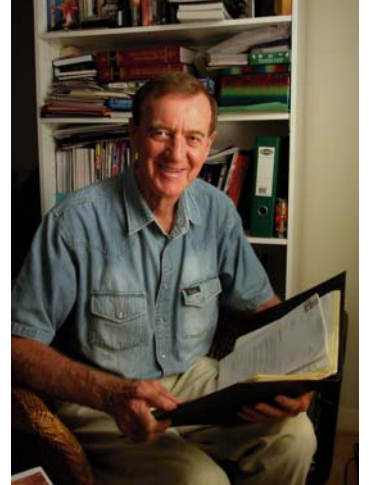
## Ron Pollard Undergraduate Scholarship Award

### Overview

The *Ron Pollard Undergraduate Scholarship Award* has been established in memory and honour of the late Ron Pollard, NSW producer and former President of the Pork Council of Australia.

Ron was instrumental in the restructure of the national pig industry associations which resulted in the formation of Australian Pork Limited, where he was elected interim Chairman.

Strength of character, 'life' teacher, leader and mentor are qualities that will always be synonymous with Ron. He played an influential role in many young peoples' lives as a mentor and teacher, hence an award which facilitates the development of undergraduates and further encourages their interest in the pork industry, is a fitting legacy.



### The Award

The *Ron Pollard Undergraduate Scholarship Award* is available to high calibre undergraduates to assist with their study. The recipient is encouraged to focus on the pork industry where possible during their course, and may wish to use the Award to investigate an area of relevance to the pork industry and stimulate a longer-term interest in a research career.

The *Ron Pollard Undergraduate Scholarship Award* is awarded in February each year and provides the recipient with a certificate and \$1500 in addition to their *Undergraduate Research Scholarship* or *Undergraduate Industry Scholarship*.

### Applications

Applicants of APL's *Undergraduate Research Scholarship* or *Undergraduate Industry Scholarship* who wish to be considered for the *Ron Pollard Undergraduate Scholarship Award* shall include with their application, in no more than 500 words, an overview of their academic achievement and commitment to furthering their interest in the pork industry.
